SERVING GOD IN THE BUSY SEASON

STORY EDWIN BUDIDHARMA

In economics, we learn what scarcity means. It is the gap between limited, scarce resources and theoretically limitless wants. This situation requires people to make decisions about how to allocate resources. And in our life, we are bound by limited time and energy, especially if we are juggling with family, work, ministry and other things in life. Today we would like to learn from Edwin Budidharma on how he can serve God in his busy life. There are three aspects for us to consider.

Priority

Setting priority is crucial to maintain a balanced life. It will ease our decision-making process because we know what should come first. For Edwin, God is the utmost priority, above family and career.

Edwin has worked at The Boeing Company for almost eight years as an engineer. As a core production engineer, it was a challenging schedule for him in the initial years. He needed to leave home around 5.30 am. Usually, the day started with a stand up meeting after shift changes on Boeing

site and finished at 4 pm. On top of that, as a dad with a working wife and two kids, he cannot miss a Thursday weekly routine (leaving the office early to pick up his kids for an extracurricular class). There were times when the workload spiked unpredictably, but still, he needed to manage the timetable. Otherwise Ollie, his wife, would be forced to bring her teaching work home, which is also not an ideal situation.

Edwin understands the importance of knowing priorities and positioning the sub priorities. We need to identify which tasks have the high value added items or give the most effect. Usually, frustration is caused by a long hour of labour with little result. If we can achieve the most impactful task, then we can use the remaining time for the next priorities.

Edwin commits to not working over Sunday. To achieve this, he needs to manage his job tasks so it doesn't compromise his Sunday commitment. In other words, sometimes it requires him doing extra time on weekdays because we ought to be excellent in our

work and should not make any excuses to not perform well in our job.

Motivation

Ever since Edwin was born again, he pledged to serve Him for the rest of his life. He said. "I will serve with all of my capacity, I will always give time for God's work."

The motivation must be deeply rooted in God so that we get the right motivation. With understanding that everything is God's blessing, Edwin joined ministry in BIC. Edwin was part of the Creative Art, Praise & Worship team, Mission and KOM.

Currently, Edwin and his wife join Sunday School Kids Army ministry. Knowing that not all children have the privilege of going to private Christian school, they want to bless other kids and bring Christian influence in the life of young children. On top of that, the kids ministry is also closely related to Bethany Family Fellowship where they can be a blessing to the parents too. Maintaining close relationships with families in church is important. Building close knit in Christian family communities will also improve communication between the congregation.

Combining correct motivation and priorities will result in a joyous or nonburdened ministry. Our ministry will not last long with wrong motivation. We will not achieve the maximum outcome if we have the wrong priority. To be a blessing for others,

both of them need to be balanced. We need to remember that our first ministry is our Jerusalem, which is our family. One day, Daphne, Edwin's daughter, asked him after church when he would have time for her. This conversation struck and rebuked him. Ministry must not cost communication breakdown with spouse and children. This is emphasising that right motivation, and it must be followed with the right priority in order to accomplish harmony in our life.

Wisdom

It is easier to say rather than doing it. We need to ask for wisdom from God to be able to live our life, especially in our busy lifestyle. The Word of God is an important source of knowledge to gain wisdom. Let us consider these verses.

Romans 8:28

"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose."

1 Corinthians 10:13

"No test or temptation that comes your way is beyond the course of what others have had to face. All you need to remember is that God will never let you down; he'll never let you be pushed past your limit; he'll always be there to help you come through it."
