However, our Christian journey does not stop when we found God, it is the starting point where we build a relationship with our Creator. Love is the foundation for our journey walking together with God on earth and as we experience His grace, love, and mercy towards us, our hearts will be filled by His presence to spread love among others.

We, as believers, must examine ourselves from time to time regarding our faith in love for Him. I praise God that He sustains my faith, grounded and rooted in love, and I grow more in love with Him from time to time. I do believe when we sincerely seek God and find a way to appreciate His presence, read His word, meditate upon it, sacrifice our time for communion, and truly live apart of the flesh, God will open a new portal of doors for us to experience and love Him more.

#### Growing in the love of God

It is important for us to also examine ourselves grounded in His word. It is very easy for us

being manipulated by the emotions of our mind thinking that we are in love while we live our lives in the other direction of His commands. This is why the foundational truth of our belief, which is His word. is important. Although there are many scriptural references, one of the indicators to tell if we truly love God is from this verse: lesus said in John 14:15 "If you love Me, keep My commandments". 

This is what happened in Sodom and Gomorrah, in 2 Peter 2:8 "for that righteous man, dwelling among them, tormented his righteous soul from day to day by seeing and hearing their lawless deeds". I know how dangerous the media and movies are nowadays, I have equipped my spirit to be sensitive towards the tools and weapons of the satanic kingdom upon a believer's life and to close down and reject any entertainment in my life.


