PSALM 73:23-26

PSALM 76:7-12

PSALM 77:1-14

FIX YOUR FOCUS

Fix your focus! Let's increase your focus on God and not on your problems. Let us do what the Psalmist wrote in these verses: 1) Cry out to God for help, 2) Seek God, 3) Praise God for His greatness.
