THE TRUE JUDGMENT

Judgment is an opinion formed after carefully studying something. People have the tendency to judge someone or something around them too quickly. For example, you have a classmate who keeps sulking and doesn't talk much in school. You might be judging him of being rude and unfriendly. We only judge a person or a situation based on what we see with our eyes. There are actually things and some other conditions that we do not see with our eyes and they might be the real reason of what we see. Usually when we judge, we do it rather unfairly.

Through Zechariah, God is reminding you and me about how to apply a true judgment. Making a true judgment is to show kindness, mercy and compassion to others, not to oppress people who are already oppressed by their circumstance, and not to think badly against others

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ZECHARIAH 9:9-10

THE KING OF KINGS

Let's rejoice because the King of kings has humbled Himself to come and has chosen us to be His precious children.

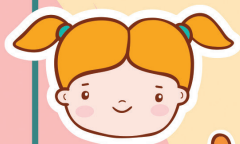

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ZECHARIAH 11:4-17

YOU ARE PRICELESS

There are prices for goods and services. There is a price to pay when you wish to buy an ice cream. There are also prices to pay when you eat in the restaurant; you have to pay for the food as well as the service charge.

Israel had been led by poor shepherds who did not do a good job in looking after them. God punished those leaders. Then, God told Zechariah to show the Israelites how a good shepherd was supposed to be. However, the people resented him and they preferred being led by the bad shepherds. They rejected Zechariah and insulted him by giving him a very little amount of wage.

Sometimes, there are some people who might undervalue and underestimate you. They might look down on and reject you. Do not be sad nor be discouraged. Your value is not what others say or think about you. You might also feel or think that you are worthless. Your value is not what you say or think about yourself either. Your value is purely what God says about you.

God thinks that you are worth dying for and He did die on the cross for you. It is because You are priceless. You are precious.

Key verse:

Isaiah 43:4

You are precious to Me, and I have given you a special place of honour. I love you. That's why I am willing to trade with others, to give up whole nations, to save your life.

MALACHI 1

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RESPECT AND LOVE

When God told His people "I love you, people", He really meant it. He really showed and expressed His love to His people with respect, action and sacrifice. However, His children did not do the same.

The Israelites might say they trusted and worshipped God but their action said the opposite. Israel showed disrespect for God and yet He continued to be patient with them. His people, whom He loved and chose, neglected Him and brought Him sacrifices of animals that were hurt, crippled and sick. They gave God the leftover animals, not the best.

Respect is one of the greatest expressions of love. Respect in a relationship with God is reflected in how we treat God on a daily basis. We must consistently give God our best, not our leftover time or effort. He wants us to bring our lives as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to Him, in every day of our lives.

When we start to treat God as if He were not there or when our thoughts, words and actions go against God's words, it is time we repented. Let's give our best to Him always in the way we think, speak and act.

GOD'S HOLY NAME

Do you like it when your friends make fun of your name? No one likes to be made fun of especially when it's related to their names. Our name is our identity, given by our parents and it will stick with us forever. You will want people to respect your name.

The same thing applies to God's name. God commands us to honour His name. We have to show respect and honour to God's name. God says not to misuse His name or speak of His name in vain.

For example, we've heard many people mention Jesus' name, when they are surprised, angry or when they are swearing. They say Jesus' name without any intention to have a personal talk with Jesus. This is not honouring His name.

There is power in the name of Jesus. It is the name above all names. It is not just merely a name. Acts 4:12 says "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." Let's show honour to His name that brings salvation upon the world.

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MALACHI 4:2-3

Through Malachi, God described the Sun of Righteousness. The One described as the "Sun of Righteousness" is no other than Jesus Christ!

With light, we can see things better. This is how Jesus works. His light will make sense out of things. Jesus gives light to the darkness of our lives.

Darkness can be dangerous. Without light, we can't see the path in front of us thus we might trip, bump into things and fall. Just like the sun that gives us light, the light of Jesus makes us able to see things in life clearly and thus, He guards us from falling.
