PERSEVERANCE & PATIENCE

There were two groups of people in Iconium. The first group believed that Paul and Barnabas were teaching about the true God to them. While, the second group refused to believe and this group of people even influenced other people to go against Paul and Barnabas.

Knowing this, Paul and Barnabas stayed in Iconium for a longer time in order to share about God and convince more people to receive Jesus as their Saviour. They were perseverant in speaking boldly about God to them.
