- Love one another. Forgive those who have wronged us and do not treat others badly. (verse 7)
- 3. Get rid of all the sinful ways of life. Live in righteousness as people who have been washed, sanctified and justified in the name of Jesus. (verses 9-10)

Such a beautiful transformation that Jesus has made in us. Let's be thankful every single day!

Key verse:

1 Corinthians 6:11 You were washed clean, you were made holy, and you were made right with God in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.
