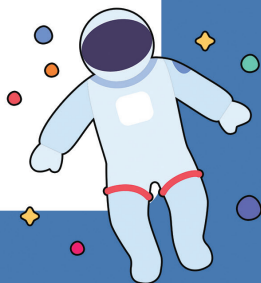

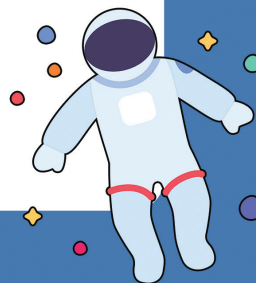

Serving God with your heart means showing love to God by obeying all His commands. You also show kindness to other people who are in need.

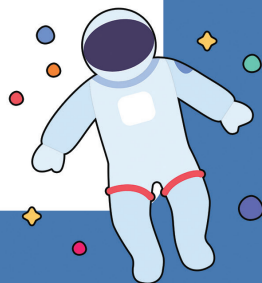
Serving God with your mind is thinking about and remembering all God's words and telling God's words to others. You can also think about what you could do to others who are in need.

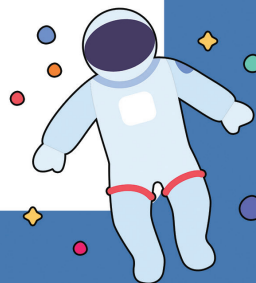
It is also important to return some of the blessings to God; for example, by giving your tithe, offering or helping people who are in need.

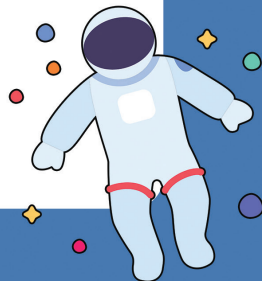
Let's appreciate everyone that God has placed around us and be a blessing to them as they are part of God's plan in your amazing life.

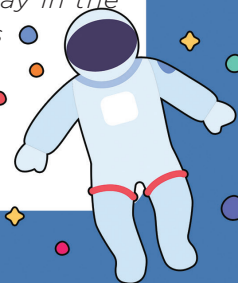

GETTING RIGHT WITH GOD

After Solomon dedicated the temple, God appeared to him and gave him four important things to note to be getting right with God. Getting right with God means doing all God's commandments and being away from sins.

The four important things that Solomon pointed out were:

1. To acknowledge their sins.
2. To pray and humbly confess their sins.
3. To seek God's face, with a desire for a close relationship with God, where they seek God as GOD.
4. To repent, which means to turn away from wicked ways and turn to God's ways.

Only if they did all these steps would God forgive their sins and hear their prayers.

Getting right with God must be accompanied by faith in Jesus, who took the punishments for all your sins and saved you from eternal death. Getting right with God is a matter of your response to what Jesus has done in your life. Are you ready to be getting right with God?
