LIKE THE DEER PANTS FOR WATER

Water is very important to the human's body. When you are thirsty and tired, the first thing that comes to your mind is water. It is because water will refresh your body.

King David wrote "As the deer pants for streams of water". He might be imagining a deer in the desert, a dry place with no water. It longs for water to quench its thirst.

Just like how water is so important to your physical body, the living God is equally important to your soul. King David wrote that he was thirsty for God and he wanted more of God as much as how we really want to have a sip of water when we're tired and thirsty. It reminds us that God refreshes us and restores us when we spend time with Him, just like water refreshes and restores us when we are hot and thirsty.

Do not replace your thirst for God with other things, like sports, movies, social media or foods. They are all temporary and they will not quench the thirst of your soul. Only God can quench the thirst of your soul.

Key verse:


Psalm 42:2a I thirst for the living God.

PSALM 46

BE STILL

here is so much noise around us. The noise of people talking, train moving, cars honking, airplanes flying overhead, loud music, kids screaming, birds chirping and so on. If you are talking with someone over the phone, you will have to find a guiet spot to minimise the noise. This way, you and the other person will be able to communicate better.

Be still means be calm, quiet and stop moving. When you can 'be still', you will be able to think clearly and positively. Too much noise can cause you to feel anxious and jumpy and it will also be very difficult for you to recognise God's voice when He speaks to you.
