A lizard is small and can be easily caught, yet, it is able to sneak into the kings' palaces which are heavily guarded by men. Be persistent and perseverant like a lizard.

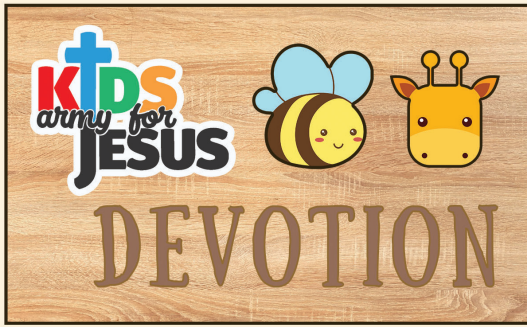
### Key verse:

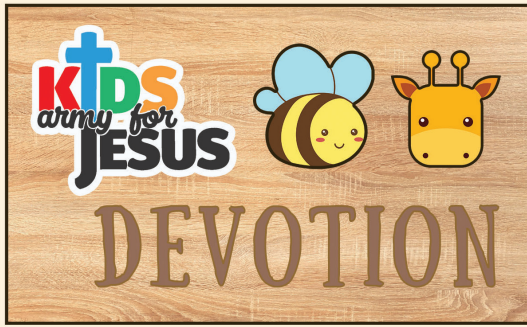

Two are better than one because they are stronger together and harder to fall apart. God made you and me to encourage one another so that we can show care and remind and encourage one another.

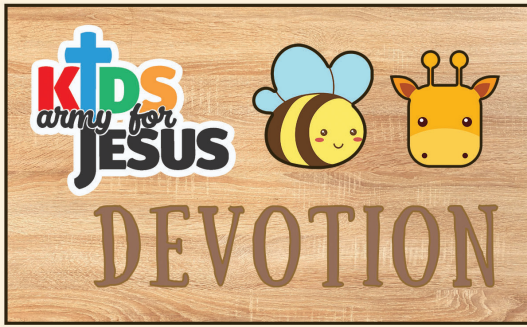

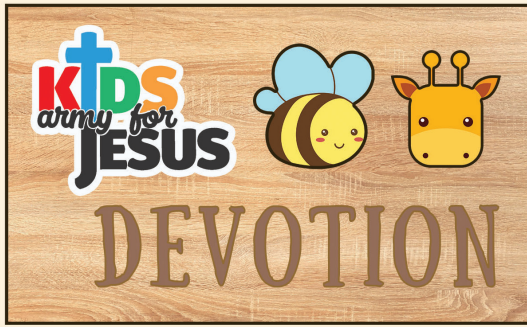

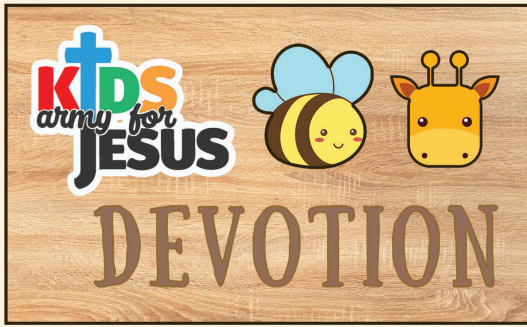

### **Key verse:**

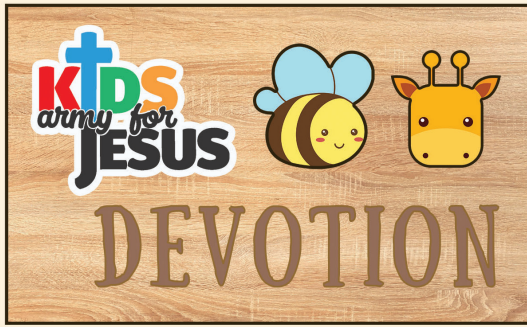
*Ecclesiastes 9:9b...*
